HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT BILL

HAVE YOUR SAY

Invitations for Public Comments and Submissions

The Human Resource Development Advisory Council (HRDAC) is pleased to invite stakeholders and interested parties to make written submissions on the Lay Draft of the Human Resource Development Bill.

The key purpose of the Bill is to merge the Tertiary Education Council (TEC), the Botswana Training Authority (BOTA) the Manpower Planning Unit (MPU) and the Labour Market Observatory (LMO) of the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning into the proposed Human Resource Development Council. It is planned that the Minister of Education and Skills Development will lay the Bill before the National Assembly for consideration and approval during the November 2011 session. of Parliament.

The Human Resource Development Council (HRDC) is being established to drive the implementation of the National Human Resource Development Strategy which was approved by Cabinet in January 2009.

The organisational design and the necessary legislative intervention that will be required to establish the Council as a statutory body has been finalised and endorsed in principle by Government.

On May 11th 2011 His Excellency the President approved the Cabinet Memorandum (*ES HRD 10/11 1*) authorising the drafting of the Human Resource Development Bill.
